#### General

- Greetings and introductions (formal and informal)
- Giving some basic information about yourself
- Enquiring about people's wellbeing and saying how you are
- Understanding and using German numbers
- Alphabet and spelling
- Talking about your family
- Saying what you like doing in your free time
- Asking for and giving directions
- Ordering drinks and snacks in a café or bar
- Talking about the weather
- Expressing likes and dislikes and stating preferences
- Being polite and respectful in German – do's and don't's

- Welcoming a visitor and making conversation
- Talking about countries, nationalities and languages
- Dealing with times and dates
- Discussing programmes and work schedules
- Describing company departments
- Giving directions inside a building
- Requesting information

### **Grammar and Language Points**

- Regular and irregular verbs in present tense
- The verbs *haben* and *sein* in both present and past tense
- Word order in main clauses
- Open and closed questions
- Gender of nouns
- Nominative and accusative case
- Ordinal numbers
